# QUICK START GUIDE

## Chinstrap

Gently pull the padded chinstrap outward and slide the helmet onto your head. Route the chinstrap under your chin, then thread it through both D-Rings. To fasten securely, thread chinstrap back through the D-Ring closest to your neck, and pull.




**Note:** Check the chinstrap's position and tension regularly to ensure proper fit.



## Intelligent Noise Control™ (INC)




